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SAFETY PROTOCOLS

As USLAW re-engages with live events, our organization has established several COVID-19 safety procedures in conjunction with host hotels and venues. In addition, we will be monitoring both CDC and state/local guidelines. As we proceed over the coming months, we will adjust these safety procedures as necessary and will communicate them with participants in advance of the event. The combined health, safety, and well-being of all attendees is our primary focus.



At the time of the production of this invitation, the following are a few of the safety protocols that will be in place. We will update all attendees with any changes prior to the event.

- All Women's Connection attendees will receive a COVID-19 rapid antigen test immediately upon arrival at the St. Regis Deer Valley. If an attendee tests positive, USLAW will arrange for the attendee to receive an off-site PCR test.
- A symptom survey will be required to be completed upon arrival.
- Temperature checks will be done upon arrival and at the beginning of the day on June 25 and 26.
- Telehealth services will be provided for all attendees if necessary or requested by an attendee.
- Masks will be required to be worn in all public spaces in the hotel and at all USLAW functions except for when food and beverage are served.
- Meeting rooms will be set up to maximize social distancing. The hotel may require assigned seating for USLAW meetings to ensure contact tracing is feasible.
- If an attendee is confirmed COVID-19 positive, USLAW and the hotel will assist the individual regarding extended lodging and arrangements to return home, if necessary.
- Capacity for the Women's Connection will be limited to no more than 120 people.

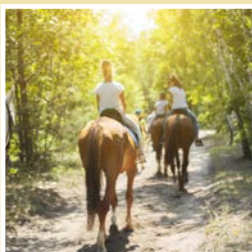
